

Glogster EDU Basic Previewing, Saving and Publishing Your Glog

1. To see what your Glog will look like to others, click the Preview button located in the upper-right hand corner of your screen.



2. This will display the glog as if it were "live".

3. Exit without saving click the Exit button.



4. To Save the Glog, press the Save or Publish button.

- A. Name the Glog
- B. Choose a category
- C. Add tags
- D. Choose Finished or Unfinished.



Or in View mode click Share Glog button and options will pop up for you to select with whom you want to share it.




Click on the network and it will take you to your login screen if you are not logged in.

6. If you choose to View your Glog you have a few more options to edit.

You can edit this Glog so that it is Public for all to see. By default it is Private because of the education account.

You can rename, add new tags, give it a category and then click submit changes for it to take effect. You can also add comments if you like.



8. Embed into your webpage. Copy the code and paste in your website.



9. Send it to friends.

Type in the recipients e-Mail address and add a message if you like. Or add them via your address book. Click Send to Friends.



10. Add to Edmodo.

You will need to log in first then choose library to upload your glog.

You will need to click on the link tab to be able to upload your glog.

Copy and paste the embed code, name the Glog then click Add to Library.



Back at your main screen, add a message, click Library to add the uploaded Glog then select whom to send it to.



12. To add your Glog to Wikispaces you must first login into your wikispaces account. Next navigate to the page you wish to add your glog to and click Edit.



Next click the Widget Button located in the middle of the toolbar. It looks like a TV screen.



Click on the Poster link at the bottom of the navigation bar located on the left.



Glogster logo will appear in the window. Click it, then you will have to log in if you haven't already done so.



Select the Glog you wish to upload/add to your wiki. You also have the option of viewing the glog first. Once selected, click Insert Glog.
